

HOW TO WALK INTO YOUR MIRACLES

- Many Christians today, especially the young ones live a defeated life. Some decide to indulge in unlawful acts, and even suicide is more common among young people.
- It seems like what the Bible promises doesn't resonate well with them.
- Something somewhere is wrong! Or the secrets of the Gospel are not well understood.

See what Apostle John says in **3 John 1:1-2 KJV**

The Elder, To the beloved Gaius, whom I love in truth: ²Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.

There are secrets to the divine miracles that we all need to know and do.

I. RECOGNIZE THE ANOINTING OF GOD IN YOU.

¹⁸ The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, ¹⁹ To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. **Luke 4:18-19 KJV**

- A. People whom God uses mightily know that they carry anointing.
- Peter knew he neither had silver nor gold at that time but he had something more than silver and gold put, all together.

⁶ Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk." ⁷ And he took him by the right hand and lifted him up, and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength." (Acts 3:6-7 KJV)

- Do you recognize the type of anointing God has blessed you with, or you are still in the searching mode?
- B. Victory in life comes when you know who you are in Christ and what you carry inside you.
- C. Young people do have a big issue here that is why they keep changing careers, jobs, churches, friends, girlfriends, etc.
- Like Peter, Jesus always knew what He was carrying:

*¹⁸ The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, ¹⁹ To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. **Luke 4:18-19 KJV***

II. USE WHAT YOU CURRENTLY HAVE TO CREATE MIRACLES.

"...And David said to Saul, "I cannot walk with these, for I have not tested them." So David took them off. Then he took his staff in his hand; and he chose for himself five smooth stones from the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag, in a pouch which he had, and his sling was in his hand. And he drew near to the Philistine." **1 Samuel 17:39-40 NKJV**

⁴⁹ Then David put his hand in his bag and took out a stone; and he slung it and struck the Philistine in his forehead, so that the stone sank into his forehead, and he fell on his face to the earth. ⁵⁰ So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone, and struck the Philistine and killed him. But there was no sword in the hand of David. ⁵¹ Therefore David ran and stood over the Philistine, took his sword and drew it out of its sheath and killed him, and cut off his head with it.

- A. God can anoint anything you have and you love doing.
- He anointed David's sling to save the whole country of Israel.
 - He anointed Moses's walking stick to deliver Israel from bondage (Ex 4:2).
 - God even anointed a donkey to prophesy to Balaam (Num. 22:21-39).

- Elisha's mantle that was got from Elijah divided the Jordan River.
 - He anointed the widow's small jar of oil to save her children from being taken as slaves (2 Kings 4:1-6)
- B. Do not overlook the small thing/knowledge or idea you already have while continuing to look and pray for more novel and bigger things. You will try and try and yet fail.
- Remember the story of the two fish and 5 loaves in John 6:5-13

When Jesus looked up and saw a great crowd coming toward him, he said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?" ⁶ He asked this only to test him, for he already had in mind what he was going to do. ⁷ Philip answered him, "It would take more than half a year's wages to buy enough bread for each one to have a bite!" ⁸ Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up, ⁹ "*Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?*" ¹⁰ Jesus said, "*Have the people sit down.*" There was plenty of grass in that place, and they sat down (about five thousand men were there). ¹¹ Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish.

- Don't overlook what you have currently.
 - Your 2 fish and 5 loaves could be an idea, specific knowledge, your strength, etc. Just make Jesus real in your situation and He will do it for you.
- C. Your job is to put things in order, God will do the rest that is beyond your capacity: "*Have the people sit down,*" He says.

III. KNOW HOW TO ENGAGE YOUR SPIRITUAL HANDS.

"But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach)." **Romans 10:8 NKJV**

- A. Remember your spiritual hands are words.
- B. Your words must be full of the Spirit and wisdom.

"Brothers and sisters, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them." **Acts 6:3 NIV**

- Always speak with wisdom the words of truth.
- You can forget many good things when you speak without wisdom.
- Prophecies without wisdom destroy lives.

"Wisdom is the principal thing; Therefore get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding." **Proverbs 4:7 NKJV**

- C. What you see with your physical eyes started from the spirit world.
- Jeremiah was created, ordained, and set apart long, long, long ago in the spirit world as any of us.
 - But timing is what matters. Never give up because of the longevity of time. It shall come to pass in due time.
